Minimum Requirements and Working Conditions

- Must possess and maintain a minimum of two (2) ASE certifications in collision repair and refinishing (ASE B2, B3, B4, B5, B6)
- Must possess a valid Class "D" Driver License and obtain a Class "A" Commercial Driver License (CDL) with a tanker endorsement within the first six (6) months of employment
- Reside within a 25-mile radius of maintenance building upon date of hire
- Lift and carry 40 pounds frequently and 80 pounds occasionally
- Ability to work long hours if needed, various work shifts, possibly in extreme weather conditions
- Required to be on call outside of regularly scheduled working hours
- Ability to climb ladders, scaffolding, work in confined spaces and elevated or high work areas
- Exposure to fumes, dust, dirt, unpleasant odors, loud noise, vibration, hazardous materials, surface spills, human blood, bodily fluids, animal carcasses
