




Historical Capital Program






Future Capital Program (\$/Year)



The Disparity Study?

- Examines evidence to determine whether there is a statistically significant difference between the availability and utilization of minority and female owned companies.
- The results of the disparity study may identify and justify the establishment of goals for MBE/DBE participation in the various contracts.



MBE/DBE PROGRAM Certification

A Business Enterprise is eligible for certification if:

- The Business is owned, operated and controlled by one or more Minority or Disadvantaged Persons who have at least 51% ownership
- The Minority or Disadvantaged Persons who own the Business have operational and managerial control, interest in capital, and earnings commensurate with the percentage of ownership
