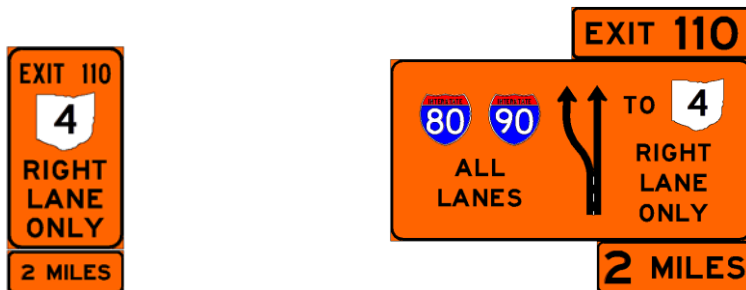
Exit 110 in Erie County to close on Wednesday night, 6/1/16

BEREA (May 31, 2016) – The Ohio Turnpike eastbound entrance and exit ramps at Exit 110 (Sandusky-Bellevue) will close on Wed., June 1 from 11:30 p.m. until approximately 4:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 2.

As part of an ongoing full depth pavement replacement program, two lanes are being maintained in both directions between Groton and Oxford Townships (Milepost 107.30 to 112.45 in Erie County).

Following completion of the Exit 110 night-time ramp closure on June 1-2, eastbound customers wishing to exit at Exit 110 must use the right lane only until the project is completed on or about Nov. 12, 2016, due to a divided, contraflow work zone.

First set of Notification Signs located 2 miles before the traffic split:



Example of a contraflow construction zone with a lane reversal:



When the right and center lanes are zoned off for construction in one direction, then one lane from the opposite of traffic is also zoned off so that two lanes of traffic may be maintained in the same direction. Both of these lanes are separated by a barrier wall, as seen in the photo.
