Ohio Turnpike bridge project in Sandusky County may slow traffic

BEREA (Sept. 26, 2016) – Starting tonight at 8:00 p.m., weather permitting, the Ohio Turnpike eastbound between mileposts 81 and 84 in Sandusky County, will be reduced to a single lane until approximately 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 27.

The project will require a 50 mph work zone and is due to a mainline bridge deck repair of the right and center lanes on the Ohio Turnpike eastbound over the North Coast Inland Trail, west of Waggoner Road in Sandusky County.
