Ohio Turnpike to suspend fueling operations at Broadview Hts. Service Plazas

Two locations in Cuyahoga County to get fuel system upgrades

BEREA (March 28, 2016) – The Ohio Turnpike today advised its customers that Sunoco fueling stations at the Towpath and Great Lakes Service Plazas (MP 170.1) in Broadview Heights (Cuyahoga County) will be temporarily closed for renovations beginning April 3, 2016 at 7:00 a.m. until approximately July 1, 2016.

There will be no gasoline or diesel service at either location during this project. All other Ohio Turnpike Service Plazas will be open with full services available to customers.

This temporary closure is necessary for the replacement of the underground fuel piping, dispenser sumps, turbine sumps, and fuel dispensers.

Electronic message boards positioned on the mainline will advise customers of the temporary closure and fuel availability. Towpath and Great Lakes Service Plazas will remain open for food, restroom and other amenities during this construction.
