MEDIA ALERT

Water service at Commodore Perry Service Plaza to be shut off tonight

Restrooms will be restored by 1:00 a.m. and full service is expected to be restored on Thursday morning

BEREA (Jan. 24, 2017) – Starting tonight at 10:00 p.m., the Commodore Perry Service Plaza (milepost 100 eastbound) located in Clyde, Ohio will have limited services for customers due to a water main repair.

During this repair, which is expected to last approximately 3 hours, the plaza will be without restroom facilities and will have limited food and beverages. The nearest full service locations are the Wyandot (milepost 76.9 eastbound) and Vermilion Valley (milepost 139.5 eastbound) Service Plazas.

A maintenance crew will replace a broken water main pipe on turnpike property. The repairs were scheduled at night to limit any inconvenience to customers and employees.

Public restrooms will be ready for use as soon as repairs are completed at approximately 1:00 a.m. Full water, food and beverage services are expected to be restored after a mandatory 24-hour water test is conducted. During this time, a boil alert will be in effect, which is expected to be cleared at approximately 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 26.
