Ohio Turnpike to suspend fueling operations at Mantua Service Plazas

Two locations in Portage County to get fuel system upgrades

BEREA (March 31, 2017) – The Ohio Turnpike today advised its customers that Sunoco fueling stations at the Portage and Brady’s Leap Service Plazas (MP 197.0) in Mantua (Portage County) will be temporarily closed for renovations beginning April 2, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. until approximately June 30, 2017.

There will be no gasoline or diesel service at these locations during this project. However, the Portage and Brady’s Leap Service Plazas will remain open for food, restroom and other amenities during this construction.

This temporary closure is necessary for the replacement of the underground fuel piping, dispenser sumps, turbine sumps, and fuel dispensers.

Electronic message boards positioned on the mainline will advise customers of the temporary closure and fuel availability. All other Ohio Turnpike Service Plazas will be open with full services available to customers.
