Ohio Turnpike Service Plazas to offer free coffee on New Year's

BEREA (Dec. 30, 2015) – By the end of 2015, the Ohio Turnpike estimates it will have served about 53.4 million vehicles traveling on the roadway, with many customers stopping at one of the 14 service plazas to rest, grab a bite to eat and fuel up. The modern service plazas welcome thousands of customers 24 hours a day, seven days a week, including all major holidays.
