Lordstown-East Turnpike ramp closure to begin on April 27

BEREA (April 14, 2015) – Beginning April 27, the eastbound entrance ramp to the Ohio Turnpike at Exit 216 (Lordstown –East) will be closed for approximately 45 days. Beginning about June 5, 2015, the westbound exit ramp from the Ohio Turnpike at Exit 216 will be closed until about Oct. 30.

Detour routes are available at www.ohioturnpike.org/travelers/construction.

The closures are part of the Ohio Turnpike's Base Pavement Replacement project between milepost 216.10 and 221.26 in Trumbull and Mahoning Counties.

Eastbound and westbound Ohio Turnpike customers traveling in this area will encounter a lane closure on the Turnpike starting on April 21. One lane will be closed in each direction. On or about June 1, a bi-directional traffic pattern will be in use, while crews remove and replace the original base pavement in the eastbound direction.
