#### **Turnpike customers using Exit 110 northbound to SR 4 should consider alternate route**

**BEREA** (May 7, 2015) – Beginning on Monday, May 11 at 6:00 a.m., the Ohio Department of Transportation will close State Route 4 approximately four miles north of Ohio Turnpike Exit 110 in Erie County for about five days for a culvert replacement.

Ohio Turnpike customers planning to travel north to Sandusky, Cedar Point or other area attractions via State Route 4 should consider an alternate route. Southbound travel at Exit 110 on State Route 4 is not affected.
