Ohio Turnpike seeks input at public hearings for MBE/DBE disparity study

BEREA (May 6, 2015) — The Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission and the Ohio Department of Transportation are jointly conducting an independent disparity study that will assist with administration of programs for socially and economically disadvantaged, minority-owned, and woman-owned businesses.

The Commission and ODOT invite the public to participate in public hearings to receive information about the study and learn how the community can actively participate. At the hearings, study leaders also will share information about the project and provide opportunities for the contracting community to engage directly with the project team.

During each meeting, the study team will describe the disparity study including its purpose and methodology. Following the presentation, attendees will have the opportunity to submit verbal testimony about their experiences doing work in the local transportation-related contracting industry and to ask questions.
