ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M. ON FEBRUARY 13, 2024:

Q#1 Page 1, paragraph 4. - Statements of Qualification must be on file with the Turnpike to be considered a potential Respondent. Does this also apply to any subconsultants we could possibly have on our proposed team? Or do the subs just need to be ODOT-prequalified?

A#1 Respondents, not subconsultants, must have Statements of Qualifications on file with the Commission. However, any proposed subconsultants are subject to approval by the Commission before they perform any work. Any subconsultants proposed should have any and all ODOT Pre-qualifications listed in the LOI and like the Statement of Qualifications for the Commission, the Commission has final say on approval of any subconsultants proposed on the project.

**Q#2 Can you please confirm the page limit for this LOI? Is it 15 pages or 18?
The RFP states: “The Letter of Interest shall not exceed eighteen (15) pages.”**

A#2 The Letter of Interest shall not exceed 15 pages. There is only one project associated with this LOI request, so only 2 pages are required for the description of a respondent’s Project Approach.

Q#3 We are requesting clarification on the Part III LOI Requirements for the referenced procurement, Item 6 – what is the not to exceed page limit for the Technical approach? If its less than 4 pages, does that change the 15 page limit for the LOI submission?
