ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 2:00 P.M. ON FEBRUARY 16, 2021:

- Q#24 Regarding the FULL DEPTH MEDIAN PAVEMENT TYP. SECTION below. Please clarify where the cost for REPLACING the pavement build-up section being removed below is to be included or paid. For example, is it to be covered in the concrete median removed item or are they already included in the designated pavement items in the proposal?
- A#24 The cost for replacing the pavement build-up section for the removed concrete median is to be paid for in the quantities provided in the Estimated Quantities Worksheet for Proposed Legend Items 1, 2, 3, and 4 as indicated on Plan Sheet 9/127 to match the pavement build-up as shown on for the adjacent Superelevated Section (STA 205+00 to STA 209+42.80)

- Q#26 SP 614 Maintaining Traffic (pages SP-138 through SP-140) specification calls for costs of a Zone Person with a Zone Vehicle to be considered incidental to SP 614 Maintenance of Traffic when there is no specific bid item by the hour. There is minimal affected work on the mainline Turnpike on this project. Will OTIC consider adding a bid item by the hour for the Zone Person and Vehicle?
- A#26 Since there is anticipated to be minimal affected work on the mainline Turnpike, the anticipated need for a Zone Person and Zone Vehicle is minimal thus there is no need for a separate bid item for the Zone Person and Vehicle. All costs for a Zone Person are to be considered incidental and therefore included in the lump sum for Item 614, Maintaining Traffic.
- Q#27 In regards to the per project pollution insurance requirements: If the contractor has a higher than required pollution limit on a corporate aggregate basis than what is required for the OTIC's per project basis, will OTIC accept this as meeting the requirements defined in the specification?
- A#27 Yes, the Commission will accept a higher than required minimum amounts of insurance as identified in the Construction Bid Documents provided that the proposing contractor's certificate of insurance reflects the minimum insurance amount available for the project. All certificates of insurance are subject to review for compliance with contract requirements.
