

OHIO TURNPIKE AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of Motorola Equipment Under the DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program

WHEREAS, the Commission authorized the Executive Director via Resolution No. 32-2003, adopted on July 21, 2003, to participate in state contracts under the Department of Administrative Services (“DAS”) Cooperative Purchasing Program, through which members may purchase supplies, services, equipment and other materials pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04; and

WHEREAS, the Commission’s Chief Information Technology Officer reports that it is desirable to improve the capability of the Commission’s radio communication interoperability with various first responders, emergency service providers and public agencies that currently utilize the Multi-Agency Radio Communications System (“MARCS”) that the Ohio Department of Administrative Services developed and manages through the Office of Information Technology; and

WHEREAS, the communication system is supported through Motorola technology, and the Commission must purchase dispatch console equipment and peripheral hardware to gain access to the MARCS system; and

WHEREAS, the Motorola dispatch console hardware and implementation services are available through the DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program under Contract No. 573077-0, Index No. STS-073, from **Motorola Solutions, Inc.**, of **Chicago, Illinois**, in the total amount of **\$326,017.38** for the entire project; and

WHEREAS, the Commission’s Chief Technology Officer recommends that the Commission proceed with the purchase from Motorola Solutions, Inc. under the DAS Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director concurs with the Chief Technology Officer’s recommendation that the Commission approve the purchase of Motorola dispatch console hardware through the DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program for the total amount of \$326,017.38; and

WHEREAS, Commission action is necessary under Article V, Section 1.00 of the Commission’s Code of Bylaws because the expenditure required to purchase and implement the Motorola dispatch console hardware exceeds \$150,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission that the purchase of the dispatch console equipment, peripheral hardware and associated implementation services from **Motorola Solutions Inc.**, of **Chicago, Illinois**, through the DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program under Contract No. 573077, Index No. STS-073, in the total amount of **\$326,017.38** is approved; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director has the authority to approve such extra work or change orders under said contracts as a result of an increase in the planned quantities, newly mandated requirements that did not exist at the time of original contract awards, or circumstances that would create a life, safety, or health threatening situation or would unduly delay the completion of the Project or increase its costs.
