QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS THROUGH 12:00 P.M., MAY 4, 2011:

Q#1 If awarded we would be using local common carriers to complete delivery. Is this acceptable?

A#1 Yes.

Q#2 In regards to the local preference, how is it calculated? How much is it?

A#2 **There is a 5% preference for businesses having a significant economic presence in Ohio or bordering states. See the Commission's Domestic and Ohio Preference Policy for more information.**

Q#3 Have any addenda or corrections been released?

A#3 No.

Q#4 What is the anticipated award date?

A#4 **As early as May 16, 2011, or as late as June 20, 2011.**

Q#5 When is the first board meeting after the opening?

A#5 **May 16, 2011.**

Q#6 Will the award be made at a board meeting?

A#6 **Yes, either at the May 16, 2011 meeting or the June 20, 2011 meeting.**

Q#7 May we have a list of bidders who received a copy of this bid?

A#7 **See list of potential bidders attached.**

Q#8 Do any delivery locations require a pump?

A#8 **All of the maintenance building have UST's.**

Q#9 Would the Turnpike Commission consider a firm fixed price?

A#9 **No, the contract is based on the unit price differential format, with the differential being established for the length of the Contract.**

Q#10 When will tabulations be available after the opening?

A#10 Most likely the next day on the Commission's website, www.ohioturnpike.org, under the Business Drop Down Menu/Bid Invitations.

Q#11 In regards to the BWC Drug Free Worksite program, according to the BWC website this program was replaced with the BWC Drug Free Safety Program. It is still a requirement to have an application to this program attached to the bid?

A#11 Yes, it is preferable. These programs are one in the same.

Q#12 Can the locations in each group be awarded to different vendors? Or will only entire groups be awarded to separate vendors?

A#12 No. Only Group awards will be made. See page 5a of the Invitation. "Separate Contracts will be awarded, if any award be made, to the Bidder determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible for each Group."

Q#13 Also, are the sites that require deliveries of 4,000 accessible by Transport Truck (semi-truck)?

A#13 Yes.
