



QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS THROUGH 5:00 P.M., JULY 13, 2011:

Q#1 Where the minimum load shall be 9 tons or less gives the impression a bidder must bid all loads at 9 tons should the OTC decide to exercise this option. It would obviously skew the delivered price to cover any cost associated with smaller loads. One option would be to eliminate this line entirely and opt for a partial load (less than the amount stated in the “Minimum Delivery Request Quantity” line) of any size at a lump sum price. A bidder will then base their cost hourly so as not to excessively increase the base delivered price.

A#1 **Standard deliveries shall be made in trucks legally capable of hauling between fifteen (15) and twenty-five (25) tons of asphalt. It is not the Commission’s intention to routinely order standard loads less than fifteen (15) to twenty-five (25) tons. On occasion, however, the Commission may order finish loads less than said amount. If necessary, loads that are nine (9) tons or smaller may be ordered and the applicable partial load charge would apply. In such case, the Commission will pay the lump sum charge indicated by the Bidder in its Questionnaire response for ordering a load smaller than the specified minimum load.**

THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS ARE MADE TO INVITATION NO. 4165:

Please utilize the attached replacement pages in conjunction with your Bidding Documents for Invitation No. 4165.

Modifications are shown with *bold italicized* text and deletions are shown with ~~strikethrough~~ text. Bidders should make sure to replace pages 6c and 8a with the attached replacement pages.

Page 6c – QUESTIONNAIRE: Please note the modification to the “Minimum Delivery Request Quantity,” which includes the removal of the words “~~or less~~” and also indicates “N/A” in the response line meaning that no response is required next to this statement. Also, please note the response line for the “Minimum Load (tons)” question states, “*indicate here if less than nine (9) tons*” if the amount that can be delivered by the Bidder before assessing a partial load charge is less than nine (9) tons. Lastly, please note the dollar signs (\$) inserted into the answer blanks for three (3) of the questions

Page 8a – SPECIAL PROVISIONS: The first sentence of the fifth paragraph on page 8a is modified as follows: “Asphalt material shall be delivered to the Boston Maintenance Building in approved tandem-*axle*, ~~or~~ tri-axle, *or other* end dump trucks, capable of transporting load quantities of approximately ~~nine (9)~~ *fifteen (15)* to ~~twelve (12)~~ *twenty-five (25)* tons per load and approximately fifty (50) to one hundred twenty-five (125) tons per day.”

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The Asphalt Concrete-Intermediate and Base Course material shall be in accordance with the attached Specifications. The indicated requirements for the material are estimated, however, the Contract shall be drawn to cover the Commission's actual needs from the date of the Awarded Contract through November 1, 2011.

The awarded Bidder shall provide MSDS sheets and mix designs for all of the proposed materials

Following receipt of a standard Delivery Request order form as issued by the Division Superintendent, Division II (Hiram), the Contractor shall make delivery F.O.B. to the Boston Maintenance Building, forty-eight (48) hours, after receiving notification, whether oral or written, unless a longer period of time is specified. The Contractor shall provide necessary facilities and equipment in order that material may be used between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. (E.D.T. or E.S.T.) Monday through Friday, exclusive of holidays

The referred to "Delivery Request" order form shall identify the Contract and the "Delivery Request" ordering number and shall set forth the quantity, Item description, the Contract unit price, the extended total price and complete delivery instructions. For purpose of expediency however, oral requests may be placed with the Contractor as circumstances may dictate. Such oral requests will be promptly confirmed by the issuance of a written "Delivery Request "

Asphalt material shall be delivered to the Boston Maintenance Building in approved tandem-*axle*, ~~or~~ tri-axle, *or other* end dump trucks, capable of transporting load quantities of approximately ~~nine (9)~~ *fifteen (15)* to ~~twelve (12)~~ *twenty-five (25)* tons per load and approximately fifty (50) to one hundred twenty-five (125) tons per day. Trucks shall be properly equipped for the delivery of materials to the Commission's asphalt track paver on paved and non-paved surfaces. Hauling shall be performed in accordance with Section 401.11 of the ODOT CMS 2010

Toll Free Use of Turnpike:

Toll-free access for the Bidder's delivery trucks will be provided from Interchange 173 through Interchange 180. Access to the Boston Maintenance Building via the Boston Mills access drive is not permitted.

Payment:

For payment purposes, the Contractor(s) shall furnish to the Commission's Accounts Payable, 682 Prospect Street, Berea, Ohio 44017, an original form of invoice for the material furnished pursuant to each Delivery Request order. The invoice shall identify the Delivery Request to which it pertains and shall show the number of tons, the Contract unit price and the extended total price. Invoices consolidating Items contained on two (2) or more Delivery Requests are unacceptable and cannot be honored for payment.

Payment will be made on the basis of the number of tons delivered at the unit Bid price for delivery destination and shall be considered to constitute full compensation for the furnishing, transporting and handling of material and also for the use of all labor, equipment and tools incidental thereto.
