### SPECIAL NOTICE TO OHIO TURNPIKE CHARGE CUSTOMERS

#### RE: SURETY BONDS

As you are aware, Ohio implemented E-ZPass on October 1, 2009. At that time, your current surety bond covering 4 month's toll charges is no longer required to be maintained if your company is using another states' electronic tolling system.

Because you are paying a premium to your insurance company for this service or may have collateral being held, please contact them immediately and request that your surety bond with the Ohio Turnpike Commission be cancelled. We will accept a 30 days' cancellation notice rather than our standard 60 days' notice as stated in the bond.

Please note that these bonds are continuous in nature and unless cancelled, they can continue to be in effect indefinitely.

**NOTE:** If your company converted to a post-paid E-ZPass account with Ohio, and you have already established the requirements with our Customer Service Center, this notice does not apply to you.
