

**Maintenance Worker – Vehicle Equipment Services/Roadway
Division II – Hiram Maintenance Building
OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION**

The Ohio Turnpike Commission is seeking a Maintenance Worker – Vehicle Equipment Services/Roadway employee to work in our Maintenance Department – Hiram Division II location. Qualified candidates must possess two (2) years experience or training in vehicle painting and refinishing, structural/non-structural repair, damage repair, and mechanical repair. Exhibit satisfactory skill to provide for high quality workmanship of vehicle painting and refinishing. Required to reside within approximately a twenty-five (25) mile radius of the division installation and obtain a valid Class “A” Commercial Drivers License (CDL) with tanker endorsement within six (6) months of date of hire.

Knowledge and skill of vehicle and equipment maintenance and finish practices and procedures; safety practices and procedures. Skilled in the operation and use of a variety of tools and equipment including hand tools, power tools, saws, sanders, torches, etc. Perform snow and ice control operations and traffic control. Understand electrical and mechanical systems, read and understand schematics, plans and specifications; work alone on most tasks; stand, walk or bend continuously; lift and carry 40 pounds frequently and 80 pounds occasionally; use mechanical equipment; radio and telephone communications.

Assigned daily duties in the operation of servicing various vehicles and equipment; performs labor in connection with the repair and maintenance of vehicles and equipment including vehicle finish and painting, bodywork, minor mechanical and electrical work, vehicle and equipment preparation, etc.; provide any support that may be necessary at the Division. May be required to perform secondary Maintenance Worker/Roadway duties when necessary including snow and ice removal and any other duties as may be assigned by the Chief Mechanic.

WORK LOCATION

Ohio Turnpike Commission, Hiram Maintenance Building – Division II, Windham, Ohio – Portage County Milepost 198.6 Eastbound.

SALARY

The starting rate for this position is \$18.38 per hour plus benefits.

HOURS OF WORK/UNUSUAL WORK CONDITIONS

Must be able to work for extended periods of time, particularly during snow and ice season. Required to be available to work overtime during on-call hours and work overtime in emergency and other situations, considerable overtime may be necessary.
