

OHIO TURNPIKE AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

Resolution Rejecting the Bids Received on Project No. 43-23-07

WHEREAS, the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (“Commission”) published a notice in accordance with law to advertise an Invitation to Bid on a contract for Bridge Deck Repair at Albion Road over the Ohio Turnpike at Milepost 162.2, in Cuyahoga County, Ohio, designated as Project No. 43-23-07 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Commission received two (2) bids to perform the Contractor’s obligations on the Project, and the Chief Engineer’s report analyzing the bids is before the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 5537.07(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as the Instructions to Bidders, provide that the Commission may reject any and all bids; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Engineer reports that the bid submitted by The Great Lakes Construction Company is almost 125% greater than the Engineer’s estimate and the bid submitted by Suburban Maintenance & Construction, Inc. is approximately 178% greater than the Engineer’s estimate and because the bids are such a high percentage above the Engineer’s Estimate, the Chief Engineer recommends that the Commission reject both bids and rebid the Project as a full deck replacement for construction during the 2025 construction season; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Executive Director concurs with the recommendation that the Commission reject both bids received on the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has duly considered said recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission that both bids received in response to Project No. 43-23-07 are rejected.
