WHEREAS, the Commission selected a contractor to make the public improvements that Michael Baker designed as part of its Phase I Services, and Michael Baker submitted a fee proposal dated December 12, 2023, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$60,979.00, to perform the necessary Phase II Engineering Support During Construction Services ("Phase II Services") under Design Project No. 71-21-07 for Construction Project No. 43-24-06, which include, but are not limited to, consulting with the Commission on engineering questions with regard to construction of the Project, reviewing contractor's fabrication plans, preparing record plans of the completed construction, and updating bridge load rating for the rehabilitated conditions (if required), which the Chief Engineer deemed reasonable and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has reviewed the recommendation submitted by the Chief Engineer and approves the recommendation to authorize Michael Baker to perform the Phase II Services under Design Project No. 71-21-07 for Construction Project No. 43-24-06; and

WHEREAS, Commission action is necessary under Article V, Section 1.00 of the Commission's Code of Bylaws because the proposed contract modification, in additional to the previously approved modifications, exceeds the greater of \$150,000 or 10% of the original contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has duly considered such recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission that the fee proposal of Michael Baker International Inc. dated December 12, 2023, to perform the required Phase II Engineering Support During Construction Services, specifically described in the recitals, under Design Project No. 71-21-07 for Construction Project No. 43-24-06, in the amount of \$60,979.00 is accepted and approved, and the Executive Director is authorized the amend the contract with Michael Baker International Inc. to perform the Phase II Services in accordance with the terms and conditions of the existing contract and Michael Baker International Inc.'s fee proposal dated December 12, 2023, resulting in an aggregate not-to-exceed contract amount of \$490,926.00.
