

## EV Charging Sessions on the Ohio Turnpike Increase in 2024

BEREA, Ohio (Jan. 23, 2025) – Electric vehicle (EV) and plug-in hybrid EV charging sessions on the Ohio Turnpike continued to increase in 2024.

In 2024, a combined 91,356 EV charging sessions were completed at Tesla and Electrify America charging stations at eight service plazas located across the 241-mile toll road compared to 63,007 sessions\* in 2023. That is an average of 250 EV charging sessions per day in 2024, establishing a new benchmark.

The Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission's EV charging network was established through a public-private partnership with Electrify America and Tesla at no cost to the commission. Rates to charge an EV at the Ohio Turnpike's service plazas are competitive with rates off the toll road.

Currently, there are 16 Electrify America charging units at four service plazas and 64 Tesla Supercharger units at eight service plazas. For a complete listing of EV charging locations on the Ohio Turnpike, <u>click here</u>.

Electrify America opened its charging stations on the Ohio Turnpike in 2019, followed by Tesla in 2021.

The Ohio Turnpike's 14 service plazas – which are open 24-hours daily – provide travelers with numerous amenities, including vehicle refueling options, restaurants, convenience stores, well-maintained restrooms, lounge areas, and more.

\*The Tesla Superchargers at Indian Meadow/Tiffin River, Great Lakes/Towpath, and Mahoning Valley/Glacier Hills service plazas opened in August 2023.
