

OHIO TURNPIKE AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

Resolution Approving the Selection of Titan Armored, Inc. to Perform Armored Car Currency and Coin Courier Services in the Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$1,127,825.00

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2026, the Commission issued its Request for Proposals No. 13-2026 (“RFP”) to select a company to perform Armored Car Currency and Coin Courier Services for a contract term of approximately four (4) years, to commence on the effective date, and continuing through December 31, 2030; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2026, four (4) companies submitted a proposal to perform Armored Car Currency and Coin Courier Services for the Commission;

WHEREAS, as GardaWorld Cash Services, Inc. failed to provide a pricing breakdown in the manner as required by the RFP and failed to provide supplementary information upon request, the Director of Contracts Administration deemed their proposal non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, as Huntington National Bank failed to provide information related to a performance bond, as required by statute, the Director of Contracts Administration deemed their proposal non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, an Evaluation Team comprised of Toll Operations and Toll Audit staff conducted a technical review of the proposals submitted and after scoring the technical proposals, reviewed the fee proposals; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the proposal review process, the Evaluation Team concluded that the proposal submitted by Titan Armored, Inc. (“Titan”) received the highest score and delivers the best value in terms of service and price and recommends that a four (4) year contract be entered into with Titan in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,127,825.00; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Contracts Administration has determined that Titan’s proposal conforms to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Sections 5537.07 and 5537.13, proposals were solicited on the basis of the same terms and conditions with respect to the respondents and potential respondents, and the Commission may legally accept said company’s proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Opportunity and Inclusion waived the SBE goal for this contract due to the lack of subcontracting opportunities and certified firms; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has reviewed the report of the Evaluation Team and concurs with the recommendation that the agreement for Armored Car Currency and Coin Courier Services be awarded to Titan; and

WHEREAS, expenditures under the contract to be awarded for Armored Car Currency and Coin Courier Services will exceed \$150,000.00 and, therefore, in accordance with Article V, Section 1.00 of the Commission’s Code of Bylaws, Commission action is necessary for said award; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has duly considered such recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission, that the proposal submitted by Titan Armored, Inc. is hereby accepted and the Executive Director is directed to sign a contract with Titan Armored, Inc. for a term of four (4) years, and continuing through December 31, 2030, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,127,825.00, and take any and all actions necessary to properly carry out the terms of the contract.
