

OHIO TURNPIKE AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

Resolution Approving the Selection of Computer Aid, Inc. to Develop a Technology Strategic Plan in the Total Amount of \$265,702.98

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2026, the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (“Commission”) issued its Request for Proposals No. 4-2026 (“RFP”) to select a qualified consultant to develop a Technology Strategic Plan for a four (4) month contract to commence on the effective date; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2026, sixteen (16) respondents submitted a proposal to develop a Technology Strategic Plan for the Commission; and

WHEREAS, an Evaluation Team comprised of the Commission’s Chief Information Officer, General Counsel, Director of Administration and Technology Manager (“Evaluation Team”) conducted a technical review of the proposals submitted and after scoring the technical proposals, reviewed the fee proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Team requested oral presentations with the top two (2) ranked firms, which took place on July 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the proposal review process, the Evaluation Team concluded that the proposal submitted by Computer Aid, Inc. (“CAI”) received the highest score and delivers the best value in terms of service and price and recommends that a contract be entered into with CAI for a term of four (4) months, in the total amount of \$265,702.98; and

WHEREAS, if Commission staff decides to extend the contract beyond the four (4) month term, such extension will be approved in accordance with the Commission’s Contracts Policy and the Code of Bylaws, but only to such time as it is necessary to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Contracts Administration has determined that CAI’s proposal conforms to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Sections 5537.07 and 5537.13, proposals were solicited on the basis of the same terms and conditions with respect to the respondents and potential respondents, and the Commission may legally accept said firm’s proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Opportunity and Inclusion waived the SBE goal for this contract due to the lack of subcontracting opportunities and available certified firms; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has reviewed the report of the Evaluation Team and concurs with the recommendation that the agreement to Develop a Technology Strategic Plan be awarded to CAI; and

WHEREAS, expenditures under the contract to be awarded for the development of a Technology Strategic Plan will exceed \$150,000.00 and, therefore, in accordance with Article V, Section 1.00 of the Commission’s Code of Bylaws, Commission action is necessary for said award; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has duly considered such recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission that the proposal submitted by Computer Aid, Inc. is hereby accepted and the Executive Director is directed to: (1) sign a contract with Computer Aid, Inc. for a term of four (4) months, with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$265,702.98 (2) approve any additional terms if determined by the Executive Director to be in the best interest of the Commission, subject to further Commission action if required by the Code of Bylaws, but only to such time as it is necessary to complete the Project, and (3) take any and all actions necessary to properly carry out the terms of the contract.
