Bids are to be submitted in accordance with the Contract Documents prepared by the Commission.

Prevailing Wage Rates and Equal Employment Opportunity requirements are applicable to this Project.

All Bidders entering into a Contract on a Commission-administered Project and their Subcontractors will be required to be enrolled, and in good standing in a “Drug-Free Safety Program” approved by the Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation.

Pollution Liability Insurance is required under GC Art. 12.1.4 for this Project. Builder’ Risk Insurance is not required under GC Art. 12.2 for this Project.

Bids will be received for:

The Work to be performed under Project No. 39-16-02 (PART A) consists of the following:

The Work to be performed under the Contract, if any is awarded on the basis of the Bids, consists of removing and reconstructing the pavement in the right two (2) lanes and shoulder in both directions of the Ohio Turnpike. The Work includes, but is not limited to, excavating existing pavement, construct full depth pavement (bid alternates for asphalt or concrete), chemically stabilizing the subgrade, making minor slope repairs, performing drainage repairs and replacements, installing concrete barrier wall, asphalt curbs, guardrail, pavement markings and other traffic control devices, performing temporary traffic control, milling and paving two (2) inches of asphalt pavement in the third lane and left shoulder and

performing bridge maintenance on one (1) structure. The bridge maintenance Work includes, but is not limited to, performing approach slab replacements, parapet replacements, patching concrete, resetting, repairing and replacing bearings, removing and replacing expansion joint armor and associated concrete repairs, removing and replacing the expansion joint seals, repair and painting of structural steel and concrete weatherproofing.

The Work to be performed under Project No. 39-16-02 (PART B) consists of the following:

Repair of bridge superstructure components, including: replacing bridge deck joints; rehabilitating bearing devices; sealing of construction joints; maintenance of traffic; and all other items incidental to the completion of the Work.

All Work is to be performed as per the Plans, Drawings, Specifications, Special Provisions, and other Contract Documents for Project No. 39-16-02.

Bids will be accepted until **November 30, 2015, at 2:00 P.M. (Eastern Time)**, when all Bids will be accessed, opened and read aloud. To avoid a potential extension of the Bid Opening date and/or a potential rejection of all Bids, it is imperative that Bidders submit all questions in a timely manner and no later than seven (7) days prior to Bid Opening.
