- Q#2 Were there any analytics from the site that contain RCRA TCLP metals? If so, can those be released?
- A#2 All of the analytical results required for the proper completion of Corrective Actions under the State Fire Marshal's Bureau of Underground Storage Tank Regulations were provided with the Bid Invitation.

# Q#3 What is the anticipated start date for the project? What is the anticipated end date of the project?

- A#3 See page 8a of the Bid Invitation. The work is anticipated to begin around April 29, 2019 and completion to occur by August 31, 2019.
- Q#4 For the 40 mile radius, is that by how to crow flies or by miles driven?
- A#4 As the crow flies. The eligible area covered is an 80-mile-wide circle drawn around the origination sites.
