Q#54 Is clearing and grubbing required to perform the MOT Excavation and Embankment along eastbound 480 STA 55+00 thru 62+50? If so, under which bid item will payment be made?

A#54 Clearing and grubbing is included for payment with Item 615, Roads for Maintaining Traffic. The last paragraph of the Item 615 – Pavement for Maintaining Traffic, Class A, As Per Plan note on Sheet 7 of 113 states “All other requirements of CMS 615 shall apply. Temporary excavation, embankment, seeding and other work items shall be considered incidental to, and included with payment for Item 615 Roads for Maintaining Traffic.” CMS 615.03 discusses earthwork necessary for construction and removal of temporary roads, and restoration of areas to their original condition, according to Item 203. CMS 203.05 states under Subsection A “scalp the existing slope according to Item 201,” which is Clearing and Grubbing.
