



ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 12:00 PM ON FEBRUARY 1, 2018:

Q#73 In regard to the Clearing and Grubbing bid item (item 1) and itemized tree removal bid items (items 2-4). The plan notes on Sh. 32 say to remove all trees, brush, and stumps within the construction limits and all areas within forty feet of the paved shoulder including bridges. Below that, under Trees Removed, Size (items 2-4), it gives an estimate of the trees that have been marked to be removed within the right of way or easements.

From an onsite prebid visit, it appears that most of the trees that are itemized fall outside of the construction limits and/or the 40' margin, but within the right of way. There are also smaller trees and brush in those same areas. Do we just leave those in place? If we have to remove them, then where would these be paid since clearing and grubbing is only to the construction limits or the 40' margin?

Please clarify.

A#73 Yes, the smaller trees and brush outside the limits or the 40' span shall remain in place. The trees designated for removal in that outside area within the right-of-way are marked for removal, and any additional ash or dead trees within the right-of-way shall be removed at the direction of the Chief Engineer.

Q#74 We would like to offer our Eaton USSL LED and Sternberg Millenia LED as an approved equal to the specified LSI LED (and LED retrofit) and pole.

A#74 The proposed equals do not appear to meet specifications. Further, the Commission desires to maintain consistency in its lighting fixtures to control maintenance and repair inventory and supply arrangements.
