Ohio Turnpike Commission Urges Cedar Point Travelers to Avoid Toll Plaza 110 and to Exit at Toll Plaza 118

BEREA, Ohio (July 30, 2023) – Over the next 30 days, the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission is urging its toll customers – especially travelers going to Cedar Point – to avoid exiting at Toll Plaza 110 (Sandusky-Bellevue) because of an Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) roadway project and a lengthy detour on state Route 4 north.

Instead, travelers on the Ohio Turnpike should exit at Toll Plaza 118 (Sandusky-Norwalk)/U.S. 250. Toll Plaza 110 will remain open.

On Monday, July 31, 2023, the ODOT will close the intersection of state Route 4, state Route 99 and Skadden Road – between Mason Road and Portland Road in Erie County – to convert the intersection into a single-lane roundabout. The ODOT expects the reopening to occur on Tuesday, Aug. 29, 2023.
