Adam Greenslade is the Director of Government Affairs, Marketing & Communications for the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission where he has worked for nearly 10 years. He was initially hired at the Commission as the Government Affairs Director and served as the Commission's liaison with the state of Ohio's congressional delegation, legislature and the many local communities, including cities, townships and 13 counties through which the Turnpike traverses. In this role, he managed the



Commission's state legislative effort related to the Ohio Jobs & Transportation Plan, which generated \$1.5 billion in additional transportation infrastructure funding for the state of Ohio.

In 2013 he was named to his current position and tasked with the responsibility of building a newly created marketing & communications department from the ground up. In addition to government affairs, Adam also oversees a staff of five and all media relations, social media channels, the Commission's E-ZPass Retail Program; and digital, print and radio advertising/marketing programs.

Adam has 25 years of experience in government relations and public affairs. Prior to joining the Commission, Adam served as Director of Clydescope Economic Development Corporation in Clyde, Ohio and owned a full-service government relations, public affairs and grant writing firm. He has previous experience working in both chambers of the Ohio Legislature and is a registered lobbyist on the state level.
