As Chief Financial Officer, Lisa oversees all financial operations of the Commission, including accounting, finance, budgeting, treasury and debt management, payroll, *E-ZPass*[®] customer accounts, internal controls, reporting and compliance. She leads the Accounting, Payroll, and Customer Service Center departments.



Lisa joined the Commission in December 2004 as a Staff Accountant. She was promoted to the Accounting Manager in June 2006; to Assistant Comptroller in December 2012; and to Comptroller in October 2021. In July 2022, Lisa became the Commission's first woman to serve as CFO. She spent the greater part of her professional career with the Commission and was a key part of the team that implemented *E-ZPass*[®] and electronic tolling for Ohio Turnpike customers.

Prior to joining the Commission, Lisa was an Assurance Services Associate with PricewaterhouseCoopers, LLP and worked on various financial statement audits.

She received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from John Carroll University in 2003 and a Master's in Business Administration from Cleveland State University in 2004. Lisa became a Certified Public Accountant in 2009.

She is currently a member of the Finance Committee for the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association (IBTTA). She is also a member of the Ohio Society of CPAs, Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA), American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA), and the Municipal Finance Officers Association of Northeast Ohio (MFOA).
