ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M., FEBRUARY 13, 2013:

Q#1 I have a question regarding the OBWC DFSP program. Since we are a manufacturer out of the State of Illinois, do I need to apply for this program?

A#1 The Commission will entertain bids from out-of-state Bidders that demonstrate participation in, or have in place, a drug-free program comparable to the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation Drug-Free Safety Program. An out-of-state Bidder must submit its Drug-free Workplace Policy with the Bid, and the Commission will examine the policy to determine if it is comparable to the Program administered by the State of Ohio's Bureau of Worker's Compensation.

Q#2 In regard to being registered with the Ohio Secretary of State's Office, is this necessary to be considered for this bid?

Q#2 Registration with the Ohio Secretary of State's Office is not required for submitting a Bid. However, to establish the "significant Ohio economic presence" necessary to qualify for the Buy Ohio Bid Preference, an out-of-state entity must be registered and licensed to transact business in Ohio by the Ohio Secretary of State.
