**Q#10 PLEASE CLARIFY STATEMENT FOUND IN SPECIAL PROVISION NOTE 536 ON SHEET (SP-62) F.1.EPOXY SEALER, LAST SENTENCE 'EPOXY SEALERS SHALL ONLY BE USED ON PARAPET CONCRETE SURFACES OF THE NON-TURNPIKE OVERHEAD BRIDGES. WHAT DOES NON-TURNPIKE OVERHEAD BRIDGES MEAN? WILL EPOXY SEALER BE USED FOR PARAPETS ON THIS PROJECT OR WILL NON-EPOXY SEALER BE USED FOR EVERYTHING?**

*A#10 A non-Turnpike Overhead Bridge is a bridge that is not owned, or maintained by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission. Both bridges on this project are owned and maintained by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission, therefore all sealers shall be non-epoxy sealers.*
