OPENING OF THE MEETING AND INTRODUCTIONS

Stuart May, Assistant Maintenance Engineer, welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced the Project team present at the Pre-Bid meeting:

- Mr. May provided an overview of the Project as listed in the Special Provisions.
- Ms. Marsilio provided an overview of the Bidding Procedures and Commission restrictions.

Great Lakes: General Observations

- > An offer was made to examine the roof. Damschroder Roofing, Inc. chose to do so.
- Mr. May stated that all prep work needs to be given consideration and included in the bids. This includes cleaning, patching, priming, etc. to prepare surfaces for the new finishes.
- Mr. May stated that the Service Plazas and restrooms will be open during the project.
- > Mr. Kremer and Mr. May summarized the floor tile work to be performed and noted several items in the specifications: dome ceiling areas which must be

- cleaned and caulked; condiment shelves will be changed; ceiling spots must be repaired and not simply painted over;
- ▶ Mr. May further summarized: The gift store (Great Lakes and Towpath locations) will be moved from present location; adjustments will be made to the grid and tile; limited work in truckers lounge; kick plates will be added on some doors; regarding ceramic floor tile the contractor is responsible to provide all ceramic floor tile, as some tile may have a long delivery, the contractor may use any attic stock the Commission may have until the new tile is delivered.
- Mr. May also summarized outside improvements and noted exterior area must be pressure washed, caulking replaced, cover vents when pressure washing paint, doors are getting painted, poles outside service plaza building to get epoxy paint (3 coat system).
- Mr. May further noted: Fuel area canopies will be cleaned; the store and gas station will stay open.
- The site visit included areas not accessible by the public.
- Mr. May summarized work to be performed in the vendor hallway.

Towpath Service Plaza – General Observations

Mr. May noted the extensive work to be performed on the brick and block at the dock area.

Brady's Leap Service Plaza – General Observations

Mr. May noted the contractor is responsible for painting of the water tower

Portage Service Plaza – General Observations

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS ASKED AT THE PRE-BID MEETING

Q#1 Regarding Great Lakes Service Plaza, the roofer wants to know if he can core the roof if it is wet to determine the pricing?

A#1 Yes.

Q#2 Regarding Great Lakes Service Plaza, will the concepts be open when painting the dome?

A#2 Please reference Technical Specifications, Section 01010, Article 1.05.4 Scope Clarifications. All work will take place while both buildings are open to the public. Any painting in the food court area shall take place between the hours of 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM only. Burger King (SP-6) and McDonalds (SP-7) are 24-Hour operations. Starbucks at both locations is open until 2:00 AM.

- Q#3 Regarding Towpath Service Plaza, what is that light fixture in the fuel lane?
- A#3 Commission records indicate that the fixtures are a SEELUX, 150W MH., ED-17 Lamp, 14" DIA., Type Y, Catalog #B11562/120. The contractor is responsible to verify fixture information prior to ordering any parts or materials.
- Q#4 Regarding the stonework around the picnic area at Bradys Leap Service Plaza, is the Commission asking for the damaged stone to be replaced?

A#4 No.

Q#5 Regarding the sculpture (made of precast) at Bradys Leap Service Plaza main entrance, is the Commission going to ask the Contractor to paint it?

A#5 No.

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED SINCE THE PRE-BID MEETING THROUGH 12:00 PM _ June 25, 2014

- Q#6 I was at the Pre-Bid meeting today and was reviewing the roof plans and wanted to request some changes to the specs. Under R 22 of the Key Notes: In lieu of the drains being replaced, they need only reconditioned and new drain bolts installed. Just like we did with SP4 we would like to mechanically fasten the Duro-Last Membrane in lieu of fully adhering. Under R 24 of the Key Notes: Since we are overlaying the existing roof system around the dome ring areas the tapering is already present. No tapering around the drains is necessary. We would be conforming to the existing tapered system. We did this on SP4.
- A#6 The existing drains shall be replaced in accordance with the Contract Documents. Mechanically fastening the membrane is acceptable provided all fasteners are concealed and the manufacturer's warranty is not void or impacted and permits the install with mechanical fasteners. Bidders are to assume the insulation is in good condition and existing roof insulation system can be covered with the new roofing. Prior to installing the roof, the roofing contractor shall core the existing roof to ensure the roofing insulation is dry and in good condition to confirm no new tapering is required. Any new tapering or roof insulation that requires replacement will be incorporated by change order.

- Q#7 Regarding Dimensional Letters: On the Signage Plan, for "Sign Type N", 12" height is stated; but in the "General Notes", 9" is specified. Please clarify the desired height for the dimensional letters.
- A#7 Sign Type N letters are to be 9-inches in height. This clarification affects 6-A8.1 and 7-A8.1 Plan Sheets.
- Q#8 Some of the Sign Types have the notation "N.I.C.": Does that mean "Not in Contract" and they should not be incorporated in our bid?
- A#8 That is correct. "N.I.C." means "Not in Contract" and should not be included in the contractor's bid.
- Q#9 On drawing 7-AS1.0, Note AS22 states: replace existing mail box with new. Please verify manufacturer and model of new mail box.
- A#9 Replacement of the existing mailbox with new is hereby removed from the scope of the project. This affects 7-AS1.0 Plan Sheet.
- Q#10 On drawing 6-A4.0, in Vendor Lobby 229, it shows FRP-1 but it also calls out DP-1 which is 1/8" aluminum diamond plate base HT=4'-0". Please clarify if the diamond plate should cover the first 4 feet of the wall with FRP above. Wall section 7 on 6-A7.3 shows FRP 4'-0" from finish floor with rubber base?
- A#10 DP-1 wall treatment is NOT to be used on the Vendor Lobby walls. FRP-1 wall treatment is to be used on the Vendor Lobby walls with rubber base. This affects 6-A4.0 Plan Sheet.
- Q#11 Wall section 2 on 6-A7.6 shows a 6"H x 5/8" Dia. stainless steel base and 6"H x 7/8" Dia. stainless steel base. Please clarify what these items are.
- A#11 The base dimensions should read 6"H x 5/8" Deep and 6"H x 7/8" Deep. This affects 6.A7.6 Plan Sheet.
