






Historical Capital Program

Expenditures by Year (in millions)






Future Capital Program (\$/Year)






Project 46-2019

- Location: Williams, Fulton, Lucas, Wood, Ottawa, Sandusky, Erie, Lorain, Cuyahoga, Summit, Portage, Trumbull and Mahoning Counties
 - Milepost 0 to 241.2
- Scope of Work:
 - Furnish and apply Retro-reflective pavement markings on the Ohio Turnpike mainline roadway and interchange ramps
- Schedule:
 - Advertise for Bids: February 2018
 - Construction: May October 2018



Beyond 2019 – Toll Collection System Modifications

Modernizing the Ohio Turnpike's Toll Collection System



Mainline Considerations

- Implement highway speed E-ZPass lanes at Eastgate and Westgate (fixed tolls by vehicle class)
- Convert Eastgate to one-way collection Westbound No collection Eastbound
- Construct two mainline barrier plazas with highway speed E-ZPass lanes at MP 49 and MP 211 (new ends of closed ticket system)
- Remove 9 Toll Plazas but maintain interchange access to Turnpike (TP 13, 25, 34, 39, 215/216, 218, 232, 234)
- Maintain 2013 toll rate freeze for class 1 E-ZPass trips under 30 miles through 2023
 - Remove all entry toll lane gates and E-ZPass Only exit toll lane gates and install new license plate image capture cameras
 - Retain toll lane gates in non-E-ZPass exit lanes

Back Office Considerations

Replace Toll Collection System (TCS) and Customer Service Center (CSC) hardware/software including *E-ZPass* website Continue to staff and operate in-house *E-ZPass* Ohio CSC

Contract with vendor(s) for license plate image review, processing and collections

Impacts and Benefits of Recommended Option

- Bold step forward in technology and convenience for our customers without introducing significant revenue risk to our financial projections
- Approximately 80% of our transactions and 85% of our revenue will still be collected within the ticketed portion of the system (MP 49 through MP 211)
- · Provides non-stop travel at highway speeds (70 mph) for E-ZPass customers traveling the full length of the Ohio Turnpike
- Provides non-stop travel at low speeds (10-15 mph) at all interchange plazas (TP 52 thru TP 209) for E-ZPass customers
- Provides non-tolled trips for local travelers within TP 13 thru TP 39 and within TP 216 thru TP 232
- Barrier toll includes per mile cost for a portion of the non-tolled section (MP 2 thru MP 49 & MP 211 thru MP 239)
- Full length trip cash customers will stop 3x (EB) or 4x (WB) instead of 2x as they currently do
- Toll collection staff reductions due to removal of plazas, removal of gates on entry, increased *E-ZPass* penetration and faster collection rates at Eastgate and Westgate
- Approximately \$257 Million in Operating Cost Savings over 30 years
- Approximately \$241 Million increase in Net Revenue over 30 years
- Approximately \$189-217 Million in capital implementation costs (2017 costs)
