Minimum Requirements

Qualified candidates are required to possess the following:

- Associate of Applied Science in the electrical, plumbing, or HVAC skilled trade with two (2) years recent work experience as an electrician, plumber, or HVAC Technician in a commercial or industrial setting; or
- Completion of a Trades Apprenticeship as an electrician, plumber, or HVAC technician is required for the Division Technician IV-A classification.
- HVAC equipment and controls experience preferred.
- Valid Class "D" Ohio Driver License; a minimum of a valid Class "B" Commercial Driver License (CDL) within one (1) month of the permanent assignment or date of hire.
- Valid Class "A" Commercial Driver License (CDL) with a tanker endorsement required within six (6) months of the permanent assignment or date of hire.
- Knowledge of commercial HVAC systems; electrical and plumbing building equipment.
- Safety practices associated with building systems, components and/or equipment.
- Comprehension of plans/blueprints and schematics.
- Familiar with current code requirements; basic arithmetic; agency policies and procedures. *
- Skill in operating hand and power tools related to repair and maintenance of building electrical and mechanical components, and equipment.
- Ability to work independently on most tasks; stand, walk or bend continuously; lift and carry 40 pounds frequently and 80 pounds occasionally.
- Use mechanical equipment; radio and telephone communications.
- Use limbs/fingers easily to perform manual tasks.
- Assigned to Division II with the ability to drive throughout the distance of the Eastern Division.

Duties/Responsibilities

- Assigned duties relevant to electrical and/or plumbing skilled trades work as required for the operations of the Eastern Division, which will include maintenance buildings, toll plazas, service plazas and all other Commission maintained equipment installations.
- Provides for the necessary maintenance and repair of building systems, equipment, fans, pump and other motors, compressors, belts, filters, generators, alarm, and communication systems.
- Water and wastewater systems, associated components, and equipment.
- Building lighting systems, heating, ventilating and air conditioning equipment, HVAC controls.
- Installation of new and maintenance/repair of existing building systems including industrial/commercial type systems.
- Perform assignments that may include service and repair of equipment and power tools, performs minor repairs or miscellaneous work.
- Perform operational maintenance, minor service, and adjustment for building and physical plant; cleaning, testing, and reporting.
- Perform any other duties necessary and incidental as may be assigned by the Eastern Division Trades Supervisor and/or Assistant Trades Supervisor.

Work Location and Unusual Working Conditions

Ohio Turnpike & Infrastructure Commission, Amherst Maintenance Building – Lorain County, Milepost 141. Assigned to the Eastern Division of the roadway. Must have the ability to drive throughout the 120-mile distance of the Eastern Division.

May be exposed to extreme temperatures while working outdoors; climb ladder or scaffolding; work while on knees, work in confined spaces and elevated/high areas; exposure to fumes, dust, dirt, odor, electrical power, vibration and loud noise from traffic and equipment, and hazardous materials. Required to be available during on-call hours and work overtime in emergency and other situations.
