Job Duties:

- Assigned duties relevant to skilled electrical work as required for the operations of the respective maintenance Division, which will include maintenance buildings, toll plazas, service plazas and all other Commission maintained electrical installations.

- HVAC equipment and controls experience is preferred.

- Ability to understand electrical systems and electrical process.
