- Lift and carry 40 pounds frequently and 80 pounds occasionally
- Ability to work long hours if needed, various work shifts, possibly in extreme weather conditions
- Required to be on call outside of regularly scheduled working hours
- Possess valid Class "A" CDL within (6) months of date of hire
- Ability to climb ladders, scaffolding, work in confined spaces and elevated or high work areas
- Possess tool box and basic hand tools (i.e. wrenches, ratchets, sockets, hammers, etc.)
- Reside within a 25-mile radius of assigned work station
