#### Main Job Tasks and Work Characteristics:

- Prepares and reviews real estate transaction documents on behalf of the Commission, including conveyance documents, chain of title, real estate taxes (and exemptions), environmental impact reports, cell tower agreements, permits, licenses, and related certificates and records to accomplish the desired transaction; reviews right of way plans; coordinates communication with title companies and appraisers and reviews their work; prepares contracts and deeds under the supervision of the General Counsel; coordinates relocation program and relocation agents; consults and coordinates activities with Commission attorneys or outside counsel concerning appropriation cases; coordinates and prepares documents, including tax prorations, for property closing; handles property owner inquiries regarding signs, fences, access, and drainage; reviews permits for utilities crossing the Turnpike right of way.
- Recommends insurance coverage for all Commission operations and property; reviews and summarizes insurance policy requirements; keeps the General Counsel advised as to any changes in insurance coverage; reports claims (potential, threatened and actual) to liability insurance carriers; provides claim documentation to insurance carriers; coordinates insurance payments to OTIC; reviews insurance carrier requirements for renewing policies upon expiration; files state motor vehicle crash reports; responds to property damage claims against the Commission; reviews and approves insurance claims submitted by contracting engineers, contractors, operators, ambulance services, triple and double trailer operators; performs any other duties as may be assigned by General Counsel.
