As General Counsel, Chief Legal Officer and Chief Ethics Officer to the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission, Jen advises the Commission on a variety of legal issues, including various contracts, real estate matters, public records Ohio's sunshine requests, laws. resolutions or other actions taken by the Commission, defending law suits against the Commission and advising the Commission on external finances and related bond matters.



Jen joined the Commission on June 1, 2015 after having spent her entire legal career in private practice, most recently as a member of the business group at a major law firm in Cleveland. In private practice, Jen previously represented clients in both the public and private sectors, including trustees, government entities, banks, lenders, underwriters, issuers of debt, and borrowers on both public and private real estate development projects of all sizes, both buyers and sellers. While in private practice, Jen was appointed as Special Counsel to the Ohio Attorney General (2011-2015), during which time she has represented various State of Ohio departments, agencies, universities, colleges, and public offices in capacities including bond counsel, issuer's counsel, lender's counsel, and disclosure counsel, as well as in general contract negotiations. Jen earned her Bachelor of Arts from The Ohio State University (1991) and her juris doctorate from Cleveland-Marshall College of Law (1996).
