Ohio Turnpike prepares for Snow & Ice

BEREA (Oct. 14, 2016) – The Ohio Turnpike is preparing for the Snow and Ice season with a 136-point inspection of all snowplows and equipment.

Turnpike customers can be assured that a sufficient number of snowplows will be available at any given moment to maintain 1,395 lane miles, 31 Interchanges and 14 Service Plazas on the Ohio Turnpike.

Media members are invited to record audio and video of Turnpike snowplows and equipment and speak with employees whose responsibility it is to keep the road clear of Snow & Ice and safe for motorists. Exact times on Oct. 20 are flexible.
