Ohio Turnpike bridge project in Erie County to slow traffic this weekend

Traffic will be maintained in one lane throughout project that ends 2:00 p.m. Saturday*

BEREA (July 28, 2016) – Starting tomorrow night at 9:00 p.m., the Ohio Turnpike westbound between mileposts 119 and 116.5 in Milan Township, Erie County, will be reduced to a single lane until Saturday at approximately 2:00 p.m., weather permitting.

The project will require a 35 mph work zone due to a mainline bridge deck concrete pour on the Ohio Turnpike westbound over Kelley Road in Erie County. Westbound Cedar Point traffic is advised to use SR 2 westbound as an alternate route.
