Ohio Turnpike bridge project in Erie County to slow traffic tonight

Traffic will be maintained in one lane throughout project that ends 11:30 a.m. tomorrow*

BEREA (Oct. 18, 2016) – Starting tonight at 7:00 p.m., the Ohio Turnpike westbound between mileposts 118.5 and 117.5 over US Route 250 in Milan Township, Erie County, will be reduced to a single lane until Wednesday at 11:30 a.m., weather permitting.

The project will require a 35 mph work zone due to mainline bridge deck concrete pours of the left and center lanes on the Ohio Turnpike westbound over US Route 250.
