Lordstown-East Turnpike ramp to reopen tomorrow

BEREA (October 7, 2016) – The eastbound entrance ramp to the Ohio Turnpike at Exit 216- (Lordstown – East) in Trumbull County will reopen Saturday (tomorrow) at 1:00 a.m. This closure was needed due to the Ohio Turnpike’s ongoing full-depth pavement replacement program that took place this summer from MP 216.1 -221.2 in Mahoning County.

Ohio Turnpike crews also will implement a new traffic pattern for eastbound customers this evening. Eastbound customers will no longer utilize the bi-directional contraflow traffic pattern. All eastbound traffic will be maintained in a single lane of traffic throughout the zone until the project is complete.

The work that was performed was part of the Ohio Turnpike’s ongoing full-depth pavement replacement program, and was part of the Ohio Turnpike’s \$145 million capital improvement program, its largest in 15 years.
