Service Plazas Offer Overnight Parking and More for RVs and Travel Trailers

BEREA, Ohio (June 26, 2023) – The Ohio Turnpike offers owners of recreational vehicles (RVs) and travel trailers with the safety and convenience of overnight parking and more at eight service plazas along the 241-mile toll road.

The eight service plaza locations include:

- Indian Meadow (westbound) / Tiffin River (eastbound) at milepost 20.8;
- Blue Heron (westbound) / Wyandot (eastbound) at milepost 76.9;
- Middle Ridge (westbound) / Vermilion Valley (eastbound) at milepost 139.5; and
- Portage (westbound) / Brady's Leap (eastbound) at milepost 197.

The parking areas also provide electrical outlets (20 and 30 AMP-120 Volt, and 50 AMP-240 Volt), a wastewater dump station for black and gray water tanks, and potable water filling station — all for a \$20 fee.

Ohio Turnpike customers can use the self-pay ticket machine at the RV lot entrance, then display the receipt in the vehicle's front window or dashboard.

The service plazas are open 24 hours a day and offer the following amenities: fuel, restrooms, Wi-Fi, convenience stores, restaurants, showers, washers/dryers, ATMs, travel information and more.
