Ohio Turnpike Offers Overnight Parking and More for Recreational Vehicles and Travel Trailers

BEREA, Ohio (March 23, 2023) – Did you know that travelers on the Ohio Turnpike with recreational vehicles (RV) and travel trailers can enjoy the convenience of overnight parking with hook-ups at eight service plazas without having to exit the 241-mile toll road?

The Ohio Turnpike offers 11 parking spaces for RVs and travel trailers up to 40 feet in length at the following service plazas:

- Indian Meadow (westbound) and Tiffin River (eastbound) at milepost 20.8;
- Blue Heron (westbound) and Wyandot (eastbound) at milepost 76.9;
- Middle Ridge (westbound) and Vermilion Valley (eastbound) at milepost 139.5; and
- Portage (westbound) and Brady's Leap (eastbound) at milepost 197.

The designated parking areas are open for occupancy for a one night stay and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Customers can use the self-pay ticket machine located at the entrance to the RV lot, and then display the receipt in the window or on the dashboard.

RV parking areas also offer electrical outlets (20 and 30-120V; 50 AMP-240V), a wastewater dump station for black/gray water tanks, and potable water filling station, all for a \$20 fee.

In addition to the convenience of overnight parking and hook-ups, customers have access to all the amenities available 24 hours a day inside the service plazas, which include restrooms, showers, restaurants, ATM, vending machines, coin-operated washer/dryer and more.
