## ANSWERS TO OUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 8:00 A.M. ON FEBRUARY 28, 2022:

- Q#1 Will the OTIC be handing the traffic control necessary for these repairs? In not, please create an item to compensate the contractor for the many complicated closures that will be required.
- A#1 Traffic control will be provided by OTIC personnel. At least 48 hours prior to the need for traffic control, the awarded contractor shall make a request for the shoulder and/or lane closure(s).
- Q#2 In uploading the required bid documents, is it necessary to upload the entire bid packet or just the required forms as addressed in the bid form instructions?
- A#2 Bidders are required to submit the documents as listed in Part 5, Bid Form Instructions plus the cover page of the bid invitation, which contains the "submitted by" information.
- Q#3 Will the contractor need to obtain a permit for the crane to get on and off the Turnpike to perform the work?
- A#3 The Contractor does not need to obtain an over-dimensional permit from the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (OTIC) to transport a crane to the site. However, 48 hours prior to the crane's arrival, OTIC will need to know if the crane is over-weight, over-height, or over-width, and must be approved by OTIC for use at the site.
- Q#4 Will the Turnpike provide any lane Closures or work zone?
