- Q#1 Where should proposers place page 2(ii) of the RFQ in our response?

- Q#2 Can proposers place copies of all testing lab accreditations and certifications in the back of the document as an attachment?
- A#2 Yes, all accreditations and certifications can be placed in the document as an attachment.
- Q#3 Can additional guidelines be provided about the 17-page limit and content per section? Where can we use the extra two pages and where should we not?
- A#3 The 17-page limit for responses to multiple projects was intended to accommodate item 6 under Part III Project Approach. Essentially, it permits an additional 2-pages to the standard 15-page limit.
- Q#4 Per page 3 of the RFQ: Provide a description of your Project Approach, not to exceed two (2) pages, for each contract submission. How will these extra pages per contract affect the 17-page limit?
