ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M. ON OCTOBER 10, 2025:

- Q#1 Can you clarify the scheduling requirements as they relate to the software indicated in the LOI Item #17 Partial or draft scope of work indicates, "Reviewing, commenting, and recommending approval of the Contractor's Construction Primavera P6 Schedule for Conformance with the Commission's requirements" However the OTIC 43-26-04 bid documents have SP 120B Construction Schedule, Without Resource Loading, which does not require the use of the Primavera P6 scheduling software like SP 120A Construction Schedule with Resource Loading. Please clarify project scheduling requirements regarding software.
- A#1 The referenced sentence is revised to read "Reviewing, commenting, and recommending approval of the Contractor's Construction Schedule required under GC4.2 and identified in the project contract documents for conformance with the Commission's requirements."
- Q#2 Please confirm that listed work experience supervisor is proposed key staff's employer.
- A#2 The listed work experience supervisor refers to the direct reporting manager of the firm or Owner the person was working with at the time. Examples: for OTIC experience, the Resident Engineer or the firm Project Manager (for Resident Engineer) in charge of that project, for ODOT experience, the ODOT Project Engineer in charge of that project.
- Q#3 Please confirm that the five pages of resumes are not included in the overall 15-page limit for the LOI.
- A#3 The 15-page limit for this LOI includes the 5 page-limit for resumes.
- Q#4 Do we submit all ODOT qualifications for firms or only the ones relevant to the project?
- A#4 Part III of the LOI states what the respondent needs to submit to meet the minimum requirements of the LOI for both Prime and Subconsultants.
