ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 10:00 A.M. ON JULY 16, 2021:

Q#1 Does a consultant acting as sub-consultant have to be prequalified with the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission? In this case, we are looking at assigning CPM Scheduling Review and Analysis to a consultant firm that has not been prequalified and who is not currently working in Ohio.

A#1 The Commission does not prequalify consultants but requires a Statement of Qualifications to be on file for those who perform work for the Commission. A Statement of Qualifications may be submitted concurrently with the LOI. Please see Section 4.2 of the form Contract for Professional Services for a Construction Project (Appendix B to the LOI) for additional requirements regarding subconsultants, including that the Commission must approve subconsultants prior to a subconsultant performing any work.

Q#2 We would like access to all project plans/drawings available?

A#2 Yes, Project 58-21-02 Construction Plans and Specifications are available upon request. Due to their size, the plans and specifications must be sent through a file transfer portal (FTP). Any firms interested in receiving a copy should make a request to purchasing@ohioturnpike.org and the Commission will send the documents to that firm by FTP.

Q#3 Is the consultant responsible for testing during the project?

A#3 No, the Commission has a 3rd party Material and Testing Firm under contract for this Project.

Q#4 To clarify, under section 8 of 'PART III, LOI REQUIREMENTS', is it correct that only organizational references with contact information need listed and not corresponding project details?

A#4 Correct, only organizational references with contact information need listed.

Q#5 Under 'PART VIII, EVALUATION OF LOI's' professional design services are referenced, especially in notes A and B. In 'Appendix A Scope of Services' there is also mention of shop drawing approval. Is the consultant responsible for hiring a design firm to perform these tasks or will this be the responsibility of the project's 'Engineering Design Consultant'?

A#5 No, the Commission will have an Architectural / Engineering Firm under Contract to review Shop Drawings and answer all requests for Information. However, the Selected Firm will be responsible for workflow of all documents.
