### ANSWERS TO OUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 8:00 A.M. ON OCTOBER 27, 2021:

- Q#1 could you tell me if this is a everyday job or the frequency of which the road will need swept also how many sweepers are normally required to to complete a group?
- A#1 Pavement sweeping is typically performed twice a year, a spring and fall cleanup, lasting two to four months each. During these time periods, pavement sweeping is a daily operation (Monday Friday, weather dependent). To date for 2021, pavement sweeping has been performed 144 days. During normal operations, at a minimum one sweeper is typically used per group, however, a bidder shall be able to service all awarded groups simultaneously.
- Q#2 Will the requirement to pay prevailing wage rates apply to this contract?
- A#2 No, prevailing wage does not apply to these services.
